• Mike Taylor presented a report on behalf of the CU.He said the AGM was an informal meeting with an agenda. President Brad Foster was ill so was absent. Unrestricted assets are up to \$78,935 from \$60,000.Sales were \$80,000,down from \$120,000 but the margins remained the same.All revenue lines remained flat. Net excess for 2014 was \$4000 and for 2015 was \$18,000. Cash flow for 2014 was \$11,000 and for 2015 was \$20,513. Cash on hand is \$55,000.00. Mike feels the lease on the building will berenewed but it has not been voted on yet.

There was also Presentation on war veterans by Bill Albers.

B. Mathers questioned the lack of CU awards and Mike said there was no one to do them. Drake Richardson questioned the information on the website about the store. Mario Rea wanted to know about the 1000 dose PMV bottles availability and Mike suggested these will be difficult to get because the government wants vets to look at the birds. Ron Hastie suggests that the CU could at least post the Winbird results on their website seeing as there is no more yearbook results.

 B Mathers wanted to know about any outstanding 2016 dues and if those unpaid should be allowed to vote. With some discussion it was tabled to next the constitutional meeting. Two questions came up specifically. Are dues applicable till the end of year and if there are only 3 members can they vote at all.

A flyer for the "Flying High Scholarship Race" was distributed and a discussion on race details was held. It is looking for some more committee members to help out.

Borden Club presented their Open race details. They would like to fly Matheson with a single shipping point at \$75.00 for 5 birds before August 1. After that they will be \$20.00 per bird with no limit. Prizes will be paid out by percent at 20-10-10-and down to 14th at 5%. They felt there should be a way to reduce the cost of transportation and therefore be able to hand out more prize money. Andy Pallotta suggested that the Oshawa Gold Band race may disappear and the UNC may have an opportunity to build a premier event. Mario Rea will open a deeper discussion at the next meeting.

M.Rea proposed setting up an OB nomination series where 10 birds are nominated for a middle distance series i.e. A1 to A5. The long distance series would be A6 to A11.Only the first bird clocked would count for points. Ron Hastie said it could be done on Winbird if some formula was put into place to identify the nominated teams.

Tony Puopolo presented a new formula for the Scholarship race where a flyer can enter a 5 bird team for \$100 and fly from his own loft and bring other teams in. The station would be Engelhart on the regular UNC C series. All birds must be registered before the 1st young bird race. More discussion for next meeting.
